The International Guest Scholarships programme is aimed at young surgeons from all over the world except the United States and Canada who want to teach or conduct researches. The grant provides the opportunity to attend clinical trials and training events at the best institutions in the United States and Canada, as well as participate in various educational programs and in particular in the Clinical Congress of the American College of Surgeons (October 2019 in San Francisco, California).

Applicants: surgeons or graduates of medical universities in the speciality "Surgery", preferably aged 35 to 50 years.

To participate in the scholarship competition, you must submit a resume, completed application and supporting documents (in English), which will be considered by the commission only if the candidate seeks to teach or conduct research in the field of surgery.

In addition, candidates must provide a list of all their publications and three publications (copies or originals) from this list of their choice, as well as three letters of recommendation from colleagues (necessarily one letter from the head of the department or a member of the American Board of Surgeons the country of which the candidate is a national).

Preference will be given to candidates who do not yet have experience of training or internship in "Surgery" in institutions in the United States or Canada.
